# Course plan for family psychiatric nursing interventions

#### **Course details**

Course type: Theory 1/5 unit

Lecturer: Dr. Narjes Mousavizadeh

Students: Master's degree in Psychiatric Nursing, 3rd semester, academic year: 2023-2024 Prerequisite or concurrent: Consultation in psychiatric nursing, Adult psychiatric disorders

### **Lesson description**

• This course teaches students the necessary knowledge and skills to apply psycho-nursing interventions in family care at different stages of life, by creating an effective relationship with the family at different levels; Familiarity with psychotherapy theories and how to apply them in groups and families, intervening in crisis in order to create the necessary changes in tensions, crises and resolve conflict of roles which itself causes performance. It includes being effective and improving the health of the individual and the family.

### **Main Goal**

Introducing the family as an open social system to students and guiding them through the application of family psychotherapy theories and going through problem-solving stages at different levels of prevention, in order to meet the needs of clients and improve their health in the family.

### Behavioral goals

At the end of the course, the student is expected to be able to:

- 1. Describe the history and types of family and family therapy.
- 2. To explain the stages and conditions of family formation (marriage, importance, purpose, general and specific conditions of the couple and the principles of skills that guarantee a successful marriage).
- 3. Analyze the family as an open social system.
- 4. List the effective internal and external factors affecting it (structure, performance, role, decision-making, and communication, cultural and social factors).
- 5. Explain the roles, duties and functions of the family.
- 6. Compare the characteristics of healthy and unhealthy families.
- 7. Explain the skills of healthy living in the family using the Health Promotion model.
- 8. State the family life cycle.
- 9. Define family psychotherapy.
- 10. Explain general psychological theories.
- 11. List the characteristics of the therapist in family psychotherapy.
- 12. Explain the uses and types of family psychotherapy methods.
- 13. State the goals of family psychotherapy in each period of the life cycle.
- 14. To explain the application of theories that emphasize the behavioral, communication, structural, emotional, systemic and belief patterns of the family.
- 15. Describe the stages of family psychotherapy (examination, recognition, treatment and nursing interventions).
- 16. Explain the stages of problem solving in the family at different levels of prevention with emphasis on conflict resolution and roles in the family (Role Conflict Resolution).
- 17. To explain various tensions and crises (evolutionary, transitional and situational) in the family and strategies to reduce tension and intervene in crisis.
- 18. Describe the family focusing on the problems of children, teenagers and the elderly.

- 19. Identify family violence.
- 20. Apply psycho-nursing interventions in families with mental patients.
- 21. Describe the family focusing on mental illnesses.
- 22. Use intervention in the family focusing on mental disorders (anxiety, depression, addiction to drugs, alcohol and care giving diseases).
- 23. To identify the family suffering from social damage.
- 24. Design the rehabilitation of the family suffering from social damage.
