Main Goal Applying the principles of group therapy in different groups, in order to understand the needs, problems and abilities of the group members and create correct interactions within the group, within the framework of the nursing process at different levels. **Behavioral Goals** Behavioral Goals (Psychomotor Domain): At the end of the course, the student is expected to be able to: 1. Apply the theories related to the group on a group (teenagers, runaway girls, addicts, elderly, mental patients, etc.) at different levels of society, medical centers and educational environments. 2. Use effective methods to guide the group. 3. Present the results of the psychiatric nursing interventions in the form of a written presentation report.
